

Importing & Trade Trends




The U.S. imported \$506.4 billion of goods from China in 2021, up 16.5% from the prior year. ¹

The current Chinese trade deficit of \$355.3 billion continues to steadily rise.²

The most recent report from the U.S. government indicates that \$18.2 billion worth of imports were subject to antidumping (AD) or countervailing duty (CVD) orders.³

The AD/CVD Opportunity



Customs and Border Protection (CBP) is currently enforcing over 660 AD/CVD orders – this figure continues to grow.⁴

AD/CVD investigations are time efficient and cannot take longer than 13 months to complete. Cash deposits on imports can begin within 4 months of filing petitions – getting your business fast relief.

Successful antidumping cases frequently result in revenue increases in the first year that are multiples of the legal expenses incurred.

Pursuing AD/CVD investigations can be quite successful. **The vast majority of these cases** produce a favorable outcome for the businesses that pursue them.
